Definition of POWERS: Authorities; demons over various territories who are given authority to carry out specific orders.

WICKED SPIRITS: These are spirits with assignments specifically against the church.

The authority is in the use of His name. We can use the name of Jesus.

There has been some misunderstanding of this verse. Let's take a good look at it.

Matthew 16:19 – Amplified Bible

I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven; and whatever you bind (declare to be improper and unlawful) on earth must be what is already bound in heaven; and whatever you loose (declare lawful) on earth must be what is already loosed in heaven.

Definition of BIND: Bind, be in bonds, knit, tie, wind

Casting out and binding are two different things.

Where this word is used in scripture:

Acts 12:6

We can bind demon spirits. This ceases their operations.

You simply say, "Spirit of fear, I bind you in the name of Jesus!"

Definition of LOOSE: To loosen, break up, destroy, dissolve, melt, put off, to free fully, relieve, release, dismiss, pardon, divorce, let go, set at liberty

Where this word is used in scripture:

You simply say, "Spirit of fear, I command you to loose that person in the name of Jesus!"

You bind ______ and loose _____

Wrong teaching about binding and loosing:

- There has been a lot taught about loosing God's Spirit.
- When people pray they bind a spirit and loose the opposite thing.
- o i.e., bind violence and loose peace; bind sickness and loose healing

• Although it is understandable why people may pray like this, it is not Biblical.

The best example of this use of the word "loose" is found in the ministry of Jesus.

See here how Jesus loosed the person from the evil spirit.

Definition of DECEIVING: Roving, imposter, misleader

GIVING HEED: Paying attention to, to apply oneself to, to adhere to

It is important to understand that there are demons that are specifically assigned to the church. (DOCTRINES of demons).

King James Version uses the word "seducing" and "deceiving".

Definition of SEDUCE:

- To lead away from a duty, accepted principles, and proper conduct
- To entice or beguile into a desired state or position
- To win over or attract

1 John 4:6

• Perverse spirit

Isaiah 19:14

Definition of PERVERSE:

- To make crooked
- Directed away from what is right and good

A crooked line is still a line, but something isn't right with it.

This goes along with a deceiving spirit.

• Lying spirit

The Bible mentions a lying spirit four times – all in the Old Testament. All four of these times have to do with false prophets.

However, the Bible calls Satan himself the father of lies.

A lying spirit will tell you a lie repeatedly. If you believe it, that is the beginning of your downfall.

Suicide is the result of listening to and believing a lying spirit.

Sometimes a lie is just a twisting of the truth. (We don't have time to study it – but Leviathan, a spirit mentioned specifically in the Bible is talking about this.)

• Distressing spirit

1 Samuel 16:23

Definition of DISTRESSING:

What did that distressing spirit do?

- Saul did not function under the anointing anymore.
- It affected his holiness.
- He became prideful. (Previously he was humble.)
- He became abnormally obsessed.
- He committed suicide.
- Unclean spirit

Fear can cause illness, nervous breakdowns, mental illness, high blood pressure and many other things.

Faith brings the blessing of God into our lives – fear brings evil into our lives.

Sometimes a person can be possessed by something imaginary. We can become jealous over someone or something which is not even true.

This is the same with being offended.

Any person, group of people, or organization that directs it energy against Jesus Christ is operating by this spirit.

This teaches that government is your provider, instead of God.

- Familiar spirit

Leviticus 19:31

"Familiar" comes from a Latin word used for ______

Satan assigns familiar spirits to individuals and families.

These spirits begin the process of collecting intimate ______ on that party.

Important: This is how fortunetellers, clairvoyants, astrologers, séance mediums, and reincarnationists do their jobs!

The familiar spirit assigned to the person transmits information to the familiar spirit assigned to the medium.

The medium receives the file of information from his familiar spirit and uses it to "read" his customer.

This is where reincarnation comes from. It is a part of Hinduism but is connected with familiar spirits.

Hebrews 9:27

Definition of REINCARNATION:

- The philosophy of successive rebirth on this planet.
- It teaches that human lives are without beginning and ending.
- It teaches that human souls can return in new forms and bodies such as animals, insects, birds, or a human being.

Reincarnation is the work of familiar spirits which possess people and cause them to believe they have lived a previous life.
