2 Greek Words for "Nations"

Matthew 28:19 the Greek word "Ethnos" is used for nations

<u>Definition</u>: An ethnic group is a grouping of people who identify with each other on the basis of shared attributes that distinguish them from other groups such as a common set of traditions, ancestry, language, history, society, culture, nation, religion or social treatment.

It is where we get the word ethnic.

In **Matthew 28:19** - Jesus said - Go in my authority and make disciples (teach and instruct) all the ethnic groups- every tribe and every tongue the message of the gospel.

3.14 billion people in the world are among the unreached who have never heard the name of Jesus

There are Approximately 7,400 unreached people groups

An ______ group refers to a group of people that has very few to no believers. They may or may not have heard the Gospel. They may even be a few Christians. However, they are unable to reach the rest of their own people without outside help.

An indigenous people group is considered unreached if it is less than 2% evangelical Christian

Unengaged people group is a group of people that has no known church planting initiatives. There is no missionary or mission agency working to reach them with the gospel

<u>Facts</u>

There are 2002 languages that have no Bibles and 3425 more where only a portion of scripture has been made accessible.

One third of the world's population have no Bible, no church, and no one who can teach them God's story of salvation. Most of them have never even heard the Name of Jesus.

Only 0.37% of missionaries go to those who have never heard the name of Jesus

Less than 1% of money spent on missions actually goes to the $\frac{1}{3}$ of the population that has never had one chance to hear the good news

Oswald J. Smith - why should anyone hear the Gospel twice, before everyone has heard it once?

10/40 window

The **10/40 Window** is a term started by a Christian missionary strategist named _______ in 1990 to refer those regions of the eastern hemisphere located between 10 and 40 degrees north of the equator.

It is an area of the world that is said to have the highest level of socio-economic challenges and least access to the Christian message and Christian resources on the planet.

10/40 window includes countries in Northern Africa, the Middle East, and Asia

<u>Countries:</u> Afghanistan, Albania, Algeria, Azerbaijan, Bahrain, Bangladesh, Benin, Bhutan, Brunei, Burkina Faso, Cambodia, Chad, China, Hong Kong, Macau, Djibouti, East Timor, Egypt, Eritrea, Ethiopia, Gambia, Guinea, Guinea-Bissau, India, Indonesia, Iran, Iraq, Israel, Japan, Jordan, Kazakhstan, North Korea, Kuwait, Kyrgyzstan, Laos, Lebanon, Libya, Malaysia, Maldives, Mali, Mauritania, Mongolia, Morocco, Myanmar (Burma), Nepal, Niger, Nigeria, Oman, Pakistan, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, Senegal, Somalia, Sri Lanka, Sudan, Syria, Taiwan, Tajikistan, Thailand, Tunisia, Turkey, Turkmenistan, United Arab Emirates, Uzbekistan, Vietnam, West Bank / Gaza, Western Sahara, Yemen

Facts about the 10/40 Window

90 % of the world's poorest of the poor.

The seat of every major non-Christian religion - Islam, Buddhism, Hinduism, Animism, Atheism, and Sikhism - is headquartered in the 10/40 Window.

- 1 missionary for every 60,000 tribal people
- 1 missionary for every 179,000 Hindus
- 1 missionary for every 260,000 Buddhist
- 1 missionary for every 405,500 Muslim

In many of the 69 countries represented in the 10/40 Window, witnessing the Christian Gospel means death.

The 10/40 Window remains the darkest and most inhospitable territory to the cause of Christ and represents the greatest remaining stronghold of Satan.

Only five pennies out of every \$100 spent on missions goes to this desperately needy area of the world.

Other problems:

- Illiteracy is widespread.
- Terrorist organizations
- Child prostitution run rampant in many of these nations.
- Horrific abuse of women and children remains unchecked.
- Children as young as 18 months old are trained to be Jihad soldiers.

<u>Kosmos</u>

Mark 16:15 Jesus used a different word for "world" - Greek word "kosmos"

Mark 16:15 And He said to them, "Go into all the **world** and preach the gospel to every creature.

<u>Definition of kosmos</u>: describes anything that is ordered, is used to denote a particular political system; a system of fashion; a system found in any part of society, such as a circle of friends; or any sphere where you live and have influence.

The apostle Paul used the word ______ when he wrote that Satan was the "god of this world" (2 Corinthians 4:4).

Paul was telling us that Satan operates in the world systems. For example: he is the god of the political systems, education, entertainment, economic system
