Divisions of the Bible

• Old Testament

This includes history, prophecies about Jesus, and end time prophecy.

• Gospels

This includes the life of Jesus in the flesh and fulfilled Old Testament prophecy.

• Church Age

This includes the beginnings of the church and the present day.

• Revelation

This describes end time events, the new Heaven, and the new Earth.
