## 2. Four things that happened to Jesus on the cross

## 2 Corinthians 5:20, 21

He became sin.

Definition of TO BE or BECAME: \_\_\_\_\_

Jesus was righteous and the Father made Him to be sin.

Young's Translation – \_\_\_\_\_

He did not carry our sins, He became sin.

## Matthew 27:46

This is when God made Jesus into sin.

This is \_\_\_\_\_\_ or separation from God.

God took the sin of every man since the beginning until the last man ever to live and put it on Jesus. Only God could do that!

## Isaiah 53:1

Who is going to believe this?

Definition of ARM OF THE LORD: \_\_\_\_\_

## Isaiah 53:2

This speaks of His rejection.

## Isaiah 53:3-5

He was wounded because of our sin.

## Isaiah 53:6-8

The Lord put our sin into Him.

He was stricken because of our sin.

## Isaiah 53:9

Hebrew Definition of DEATH: \_\_\_\_\_

Jesus had to undergo \_\_\_\_\_

Adam died spiritually then physically.

Jesus died spiritually then physically.

## Isaiah 53:10, 11

The reason God was pleased is because \_\_\_\_\_

God is satisfied. There is no more penalty for sin. You do not have to pay for any sin because Jesus paid it all.

### Isaiah 53:12

He bore the sins of many.

### Psalm 22:1

David was speaking as Jesus in the first person. The spirit of prophesy came upon him. Jesus actually spoke this Psalm while on the cross. This reveals what the gospels do not.

This verse is the same as the Gospel account.

#### Psalm 22:2-8

Meaning of WORM:

This is a clear picture of Jesus on the cross.

### Psalm 22:9-12

"Bulls of Bashan" refers to the Sanhedrin; the religious leaders

## Psalm 22:13, 14

David saw what happened to Jesus ahead of time.

One thousand years before Jesus and four hundred years before crucifixion was invented, David saw what happened.

## Psalm 22:15

This is a very accurate picture of crucifixion.

#### Psalm 22:16

"Dogs" refers to Roman soldiers; Gentiles or non-Jews

#### Psalm 22:17, 18

Again, this is very accurate of the Gospel accounts.

1 Peter 2:24

#### **Galatians 3:11**

Nobody is justified by the law.

#### **Galatians 3:12, 13**

Jesus was made a curse when He hung on the cross.

Curse is the opposite of blessing.

Definition of BLESSING (Barak in Hebrew):

## Genesis 1:28

When God blessed them He gave them power to do what he told them to do.

Curse is the opposite of this.

Definition of CURSE:

Deuteronomy 28 lists the blessings of God and the curses.

- Verses 1-14 are verses of blessing.
- Verses 15-68 are verses of curse.

The fifty four verses of curse are what Jesus became and what we are redeemed from.

Because Jesus became a curse we can deduce that He became sick. Sickness is part of the curse.

## Isaiah 53:4

Definition of GRIEFS: Sicknesses

Definition of SORROWS: Pains

He carried your sickness so that you wouldn't have to.

Because Jesus became a curse we can deduce that He became poor. Poverty is part of the curse.

## 2 Corinthians 8:9

This is not speaking about spiritual poverty.

The context of chapters eight and nine is finances.
