It is translated as "Hell" ten of those times.

It is translated as "Grave" one time.

Definition of SHEAOL (Hebrew):						
Jonah was not in Hell. He was in a fish. But he speaks prophetically about Jesus.						
Jonah 2:3						
This describes the judgement of God.						
Jonah 2:6						

This is speaking about the heart of the earth.
