Romans 5:20 - 6:6

When Jesus was crucified,
God was dealing with us, not with Jesus. Jesus took our place.
Galatians 2:20

Greek: With Christ I have been co-crucified.
Christ took me to the cross with Him and I died there with Him.
Galatians 6:14
We died to the world.
The world died to us.
Romans 6:6
The cross is more than just God showing us how much He loves us.
The cross is where we died and the power of sin was broken.

declared righteous in spirit

20th Century Translation

Jesus was pronounced righteous in spirit

1 Peter 3:18

Greek: Made alive in spirit (small "s")

If Jesus became sin He had to be made alive in spirit.

How did God do it?

Acts 13:30-34

Acts 13:33 applies to the resurrection.

God said this when He raised Jesus from the dead. This does not apply to the incarnation, but rather to the resurrection.
