1. Instructions for older men

Titus 2:1, 2

Six commands to older men:

Definition of BE SOBER: Do not drink wine

- Reverent

Definition of REVERENT: To be honest

- Temperate

Definition of TEMPERATE: Sound mind, discrete, prudent, moderate, self-controlled

Definition of SOUND IN FAITH: This would be more accurately translated a pledge of faith or faithfulness

- Sound in love

This is referring to the love of God.

This is referring to patience in prayer while expecting an answer.

2. Instructions for older women

Titus 2:3, 4

Five commands to older women:

Paul was instructing older women to live holy.

- Not slanderers

Definition of SLANDERERS: Someone who brings false accusations.

The same Greek word is used to describe the devil himself in John 6:70.

Titus 2:4, 5

Eight commands to the young women:

- Love their husbands
- Love their children

Definition of DISCREET: Self-controlled; curbing one's desires and impulses; a well-balanced life

The root word in the Greek is where we get our English word "diaphragm". It is the inner muscle that regulates physical life, controlling breathing and heartbeat.

A professional singer controls the length of their tones by their diaphragm which controls the ability to breathe and moderates the heartbeat. It regulates the body.

4. Instructions for young men

Titus 2:6-8

Four commands to young men:

This means that we are to live our lives as an example for others to follow.

All of us, as Christians, are called to live our lives this way. However, young men were specifically commanded to be an example in good works.

Definition of WORKS:

- An accomplishment

When the word “good” is added to this, it means a noble work or action.

- Show integrity, reverence, and incorruptibility in doctrine

This means to be uncorrupted and sincere in your teachings.

- Have sound speech that cannot be condemned

This means that the words that we speak should bring healing.

5. Instructions for servants

Titus 2:9, 10

Four commands to servants:

- Please your masters in all things
- Do not answer back

This means do not contradict orders.

Show faithfulness in all things

6. Grace empowers us.

Titus 2:11, 12

Verse twelve is possible because of verse eleven.

The grace of God is the empowerment of God. We can do everything in verse twelve because of his grace.

Grace empowers us to live soberly, righteously, and godly.
